Need to clear regularly

With less garbage disposal bins for every square km in the neighbourhood, residents of Baskara street, Kodambakkam are facing an acute problem in disposing of their household waste.

There is a shortage of trash disposal bins which has made solid waste management difficult, laments George a long time resident. In many pockets of the neighbourhood, residents are forced to dump household waste in bins which are overflowing most of the time. Due to shortage of bins, refuse remains scattered along the road, he lamented.

Though the civic body has been appealing to people to dispose of garbage between 7pm and 8am so that the neighbourhood remains clean in the daytime, residents of many localities can be seen doing otherwise. If the residents dispose of their household waste by 8am, we can clean the bins and their surroundings before people step out of their homes in the morning," said a civic official.

The civic body must procure more bins and compactors so that more garbage can be picked up within a shorter span of time to keep the neighbourhood clean, residents appeal.



Temple, Thirukadaiyur

This is the 164th Thevara Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam and the 47th Sthalam on the south side of river Kaveri. This place was called Thirukadavur during the 6th to 7th Century and is now called Thirukadaiyur. This is one of the Atta (8) Veerattanam Temples and the other places are ThiruKovilur, Thiruvathigai, Korukkai, Kandiyur, Thirupariyalur, Vazhuvur and Thiruvirkudi. This is also one of the mooval paadal petra sthalam.

In Periyapuranam Sekkizhar records that Thirugnanasambandar came to this temple after worshipping Lord Shiva of Thitu kottaru. Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal came to this temple after worshiping Lord Shiva of Thiru Ambar. Thirugnanasambandar, Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal, Sundarar, and Vallalar have sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple. Moolavar: Sri Amithakadeswarar, Sri Amirtha Lingeswarar, Consort: Sri Abirami

Some of the important features of this temple are

This temple faces west with a 7-tier Rajagopuram and there is a 5-tier Rajagopuram on the east side also. On the west, there is a second level 5 tier Rajagopuram.

The stucco images like Devas and Asuras Churning the Thiruparkadal, Gajasmharamurthy, and Thirupanasambandar sitting on the shoulder of his father Sivapadar. Dwajasthambam, balipeedam, and Rishabam are after the 2nd level Rajagopuram.

Moolavar is a little large and called Kalasamhara Moorthy, there is a scar on the moolavar.

In Kalasamhara Moorthy Sannathi, at the base of the Moolavar scene Yama is on the floor after he was kicked by Lord Shiva bas relief is on a silver plate. This will be shown to devotees during Poojas. On the opposite side, sila moortham of Yama worshiping Lord Shiva (in the prakara). Maragatha Linga is in a safe and pooja will be conducted during early morning and evening.

In Praharam Markandeswarar, Naganatheswarar, Subramaniar, Gajalakshmi, Natarajar sabha, Pancha Lingas, Santhana Kuravarkal, Kungkuliyakalaiya Nayanar, Minister and the Merchant, Virabhadra, Brahmi, 63var, Somaskandar, Urchavars, Palliyarai and there is no Navagrahas.

Ambal is in a separate temple facing east with Dwajasthambam, Simham, and balipeedam. Abirami Andhadhi was sung by Abhirami Bhattar in praise of Ambal Abirami. The mandapam is of vavval nethi, stucco dwarapalakis are at the entrance of the sanctum sanctorum. Urchavar is with 4 hands in abhaya & varada hastam.

The 15th Century Arunagirinathar has sung hymns in praise of Lord Muruga of this temple.

The sanctum sanctorum consists of Sanctum antarala, artha mandapam and a maha mandapam.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Moovar has sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple, the original temple existed before the 7th Century. Later reconstructed as a stone temple during the Chozha period and further extended during the Pandyas and Vijayanagaras periods.

The inscriptions recorded from this temple belong to Chozhas, Pandyas, Vijayanagara Kings, and Nattukottai Nagarathars.

The inscriptions recorded from this temple belong to Chozha Kings Rajarajan-I, Rajendra Chozha-I, Kulothunga Chozha-I, Vikrama Chozha, Rajathirajan-II, Kulothunga Chozha-III, Rajarajan-III, Pandya Kings Kulasekara Pandyan, Sundara Pandyan, Konerimai Kondan, Vijayanagara Kings Krishnadevaraya, and Veera Viruppanna Udayar.

This action comes amid concerns that police personnel were forming groups to stop vehicles and issue fines indiscriminately. The new rule is expected to address complaints of excessive fines and traffic disruptions, while still tackling major causes of road accidents in the

Platform slabs removed and dumped



Protruding platform slabs removed and dumped on Valliammal Thottam Main Road is a threat to passersby, mostly senior citizens, especially during late evening hours. We have given many representations to replace the slab but no action has been taken yet, says Sambandam a retired school teacher and a long time resident.

During night hours generally senior citizen like us overlook the protruding slab and get injured, says Meenalochani, a local resident. Many cases go unreported, she added.

Replacing the slab will take about a couple of hours but the concerned are not listening to our requests. We have to live with it, laments Rajagopal another resident of the locality. Morning walkers and joggers find it very difficult at dawn and dusk, he added.

Residents are on the lookout for an early solution.

Statement issued by the Chennai Metropolitan Police Commissioner's Office: Emergency helpline: Calls to 100 are received from the State Police Control Center and arrangements have been made to provide assistance to the concerned persons within five minutes through the Chennai Metropolitan Police Radio Unit.

For this, 234 patrol vehicles are engaged in surveillance work under the supervision of Commissioner Arun and additional, joint and deputy commissioners.

been deployed to provide legal assistance. In addition, SIs and police officers are working in rotation 24 hours a day in three patrol vehicles each, namely a white Krista, Innova, and Gypsy Bolero, in the 12 police district boundaries divided into Thiruvallikeni, Adyar, and Kilpauk.

This year, in four months, 69,628 people who contacted emergency numbers were quickly attended to and their grievances were resolved.

Police to launch robotic cop at 200 locations



The latest sensational news is that at 200 locations in Chennai, Greater Chennai Police would deploy Red Button Robotic Cop with the main aim of enhancing public safety within a month.

It is noteworthy that this Robotic Cop would be equipped with the CCTV cameras that are capable of 360 degrees surveillance and panic buttons for real time communication facilities for the affected public for interacting with the police.

To use this tool in policing, the police personnel would be provided with special training. Anomalies in the public space would be detected by the robotic cop (equipped with state of art sensors and cameras) and authorities would be alerted immediately. The CCTV cameras that would cover 360 degrees would help in the investigations etc. This was according to the police department.

The law and order police personnel would provide the initial feedback and based on that the Robotic Cop would be installed at 540 locations across Chennai. This would be in the first phase. Various locations in Chennai where the Robotic Cop would be installed are shopping & transit hubs, IT Parks, places of worship and other crowd gathering places.

It was brought out by Chennai Police Commissioner Mr. Arun that the number of units would be increased to 200. To ensure a seamless response in the times of emergencies, the police dept is having plans to integrate Robotic Cop with Chennai's current surveillance systems.

Corpn deploys high-end suction sweepers to speed up city cleaning

In a move to boost sanitation and speed up cleaning operations, the Greater Chennai Corporation has introduced 10 advanced suction sweeper machines for use on city roads. Another 10 machines will be added soon, with plans to purchase 20 more in the

Each machine can clean approximately 1 km per hour, or 800 meters in dust-heavy areas, significantly improving efficiency. The machines have already been tested in some areas.

Earlier, it required 4–6 workers to clean a 500-meter stretch. Now, just two operators can manage a machine, reducing manpower needs. The collected dust is transported to primary and secondary collection centers in each zone before being sent to dump

Kilambakkam railway station set to open by July first week

Bus commuters facing difficulty accessing the Kilambakkam Kalaignar Centenary Bus Terminus (KCBT), located 25-30 km from Chennai, can expect relief soon as train services at the Kilambakkam railway station are set to begin by the first week of July.

According to Divisional Railway Manager B Vishwanath Eerya, one platform and shelters have been completed, while the second platform will be ready within 30 days. A temporary ticket office will also be set up. However, train stoppages will commence only after the state government completes the foot over bridge (FOB), as operating without it poses a safety risk for passengers.
