Voice of GOD

Sri Brahmapureeswarar Temple, Thirukadaiyur Mayanam

This is the 165th Thevara Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam and the 48th Sthalam on the south side of river Kaveri in Chozha Nadu. This place was called Kadavur Mayanam during the 6th to 7th Century and is now called Thirukadaiyur Meignanam (Thirumayanam/Thirumeignanam).

In Periyapuranam, Sekkizhar records that both Thirugnanasambandar and Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal came to this temple after worshiping Lord Shiva of Thirukadaiyur Veerattam. (Thirukadaiyur). Moolavar: Sri Brahmapureeswarar. Consort: Sri Malarkkzhal Minnammai, Sri Ammalakuja Nayagi, Sri Amalakkuya Minnammai.

Some of the important features of this temple are as follows.

The temple faces west with a newly built
Rajagopuram. An entrance arch is before the
Rajagopuram. Balipeedam and Rishabam are after the
Rajagopuram. In koshtam Durgai, Dakshinamurthy,
Narthana Vinayagar, Lingothbavar, Bhairavar,
Arthanareeswarar, Kalyana Sundarar. Gangadhara
Murthy and Urcahavars are in the sanctum.
In prakaram Bhairavar, Vinayagar, Valli Devasena
Singaravelar with bow also called as Villenthiya Velan,
Maha Vishnu as Pillai Perumal, Chandikeswarar,
Nalvar, and Chandikeswari. The theertha well called
Kasi Theertham is on the south side of the Temple in
the midst of the field.

Ambal is in a separate temple in a standing posture and facing east. Ambal is with 4 hands in abhaya varada hastam. The artha mandapam is of Vavval nethi style. Stucco images of dwarapalakis are at the entrance of the sanctum.

ARCHITECTURE

The temple consists of sanctum sanctorum, antarala, and artha mandapam.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Lord Shiva of this temple was praised by Moovar, the original temple might have existed during the 7th Century, later reconstructed as a stone temple by Chozhas and extended by the Vijayanagaras. The inscriptions recorded from this temple belong to Chozhas that too latter Chozhas and Pandyas. The inscriptions record that playing of Veena, reciting of Vedas and Sri Rudras, Taxes levied during Kulothunga Chozha-I, manpower was engaged for nandhavanam. As per the inscription this place was in Jayangonda Chozha Valanattu Akkurnattu Thirukadavur. This place was also mentioned as Thiruthondar Thogai Mangalam, Sivapada Sekara mangalam, Thiruneetruchozha mangalam and lord Shiva was called as Thirumayanamudaya Peruman.

Maha kumbhabhishekam was performed on 10th September 2014 after constructing the Rajagopuram and renovations.

LEGENDS

As per the legend, Brahma was burnt by Lord Shiva and then converted into holy water. Hence this place is called "Thiru Mayanam". Since Brahma is the creator of this world, the creation has come to a standstill. Devas requested Lord Shiva to pardon Brahma and reinstate him. Lord Shiva pardoned Brahma and reinstated him for the creation of this universe. Further, Lord Shiva gave Shiva Upadesam / Gnanam to Brahma. Hence this place is being called "Thiru Meignanam".

There are 5 places considered as holy places as Mayanam. They are Kasi mayanam, Kachi (Kanchipuram) mayanam, Thirukadaiyur Mayanam, Kazhimayanam (Sirkazhi), Veezhi Nalur Mayanam. Kadavur Theertham alias Kasi Theertham is in the form of a well, near the temple in the midst of the field. It is believed that this well was created by Lord Shiva with water from Ganga to worship Lord Shiva by Markandeya Maharishi.

Precast medians - a median or a blockage?

Precast medians are used for traffic maintenance and public safety, which has to be laid on the road. Whereas in P T Rajan Salai, K K Nagar as we see in the picture, these precast medians are put up at pedestrian passage and blocking their safety movements.

As the medians are placed comfortably in the pedestrian passage, some vendors have also started to utilise them properly for their local business.

As such the public who includes elderly, children, physically challenged also are being forced to take the regular road meant for movement of vehicles which in turn increases the risk of accident.

It clearly shows the lack of concern for the pedestrians in our city.

The concerned authorities should take immediate necessary action to clear the pedestrian passage and to place the medians in the appropriate place and ensure road safety and security which leads to the goal of our government.



Drainage pipe in Kannadasan Street

In Kannadasan Street, T. Nagar, one portion of the road has been dug up for laying drainage pipe, a while before.

But till now action has not been taken for the same and the half work done is left unattempted. A properly laid cement concrete road is dug up on one side and hence the road could not be fully utilised thereby causing hindrance to the vehicle users.

Hence authorities to look into the matter immediately and cause to complete the work thereby avoiding unnecessary bumping on the road.

Encroachments removed in T Nagar

A t least 150 eateries, fancy stalls, and merchandise stalls encroaching on the busy commercial streets of T Nagar were removed by the Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) on Wednesday. They included 52 shops on Ranganathan Street, 40 each from Natesan Street and Mambalam Market, and 20 shops from Rameshwaram Street.

Corporation officials said the crackdown followed complaints from roadusers that the stalls extended about four feet on to the streets, reducing the walking space. The



pathway to Mambalam junction gets too crowded, creating a stampede-like situation, especially in the evening from 6 to 8.30 pm. 'Removal of these encroachments is a welcome move by GCC', said Nivash, a regular commuter from T Nagar.

'Ranganathan Road stretch was fully occupied by hawkers. There was no pathway for emergency vehicles such as ambulances or fire engines to pass through. We initially warned the hawkers to remove the encroachments and move to the vending zones allotted by GCC, but they were hesitant to leave', said C Eniyan, Zone 10 Executive Engineer.
