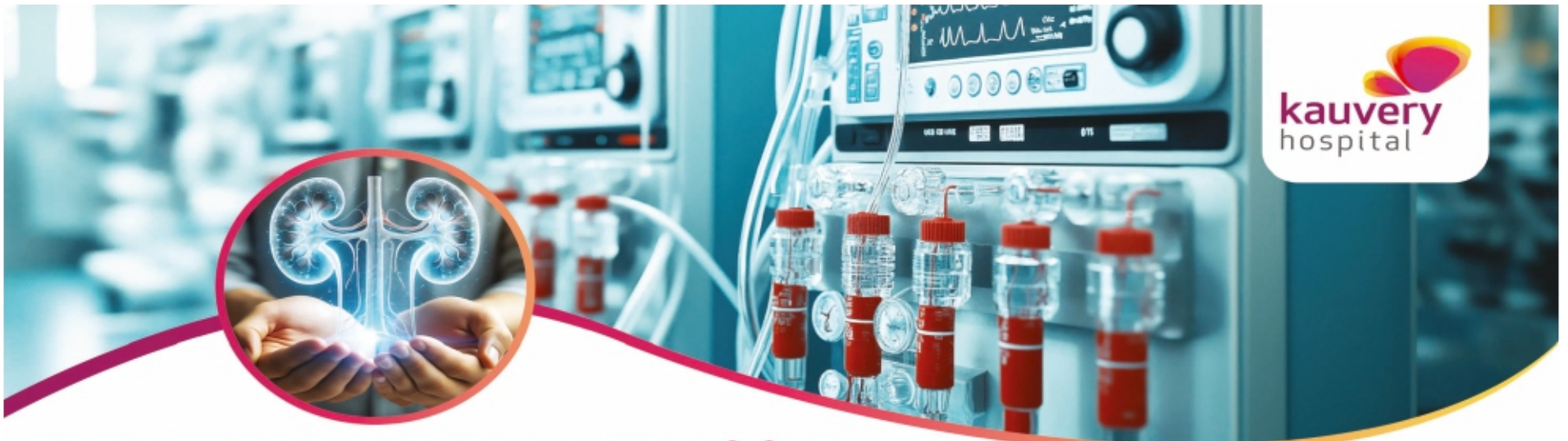

**Sri Brahmapureswarar Temple,
Thirukadaiyur-Mayanam**

This is the 165th Thevara Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam and the 48th Sthalam on the south side of river Kaveri in Chozha Nadu. This place was called Kadavur Mayanam during the 6th to 7th Century and is now called Thirukadaiyur Meignanam (Thirumayanam/Thirumeignanam).

In Periyapuranam, Sekkizhar records that both Thirugnanasambandar and Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal came to this temple after worshipping Lord Shiva of Thirukadaiyur Veerattam. (Thirukadaiyur). Moolavar : Sri Brahmapureswarar. Consort : Sri Malarkkzhai Minnammai, Sri Ammalakuja Nayagi, Sri Amalakkuya Minnammai. Some of the important features of this temple are as follows.

The temple faces west with a newly built Rajagopuram. An entrance arch is before the Rajagopuram. Balipeedam and Rishabam are after the Rajagopuram. In koshtam Durgai, Dakshinamurthy, Narthana Vinayagar, Lingothbavar, Bhairavar, Arthanareeswarar, Kalyana Sundarar. Gangadhara Murthy and Urcahavars are in the sanctum. In prakaram Bhairavar, Vinayagar, Valli Devasena Singaravelar with bow also called as Villenthiya Velan, Maha Vishnu as Pillai Perumal, Chandikeswarar, Nalvar, and Chandikeswari. The theertha well called Kasi Theertham is on the south side of the Temple in the midst of the field.

Ambal is in a separate temple in a standing posture and facing east. Ambal is with 4 hands in abhaya varada hastam. The artha mandapam is of Vavval nethi style. Stucco images of dwarapalakis are at the entrance of the sanctum.

ARCHITECTURE

The temple consists of sanctum sanctorum, antarala, and artha mandapam.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Lord Shiva of this temple was praised by Moovar, the original temple might have existed during the 7th Century, later reconstructed as a stone temple by Chozhas and extended by the Vijayanagaras. The inscriptions recorded from this temple belong to Chozhas that too latter Chozhas and Pandyas. The inscriptions record that playing of Veena, reciting of Vedas and Sri Rudras, Taxes levied during Kulothunga Chozha-I, manpower was engaged for nandhavanam. As per the inscription this place was in Jayangonda Chozha Valanattu Akkurnattu Thirukadavur. This place was also mentioned as Thiruthondar Thogai Mangalam, Sivapada Sekara mangalam, Thiruneetruchozha mangalam and lord Shiva was called as Thirumayanamudaya Peruman. Maha kumbhabhishekam was performed on 10th September 2014 after constructing the Rajagopuram and renovations.

LEGENDS

As per the legend, Brahma was burnt by Lord Shiva and then converted into holy water. Hence this place is called "Thiru Mayanam". Since Brahma is the creator of this world, the creation has come to a standstill. Devas requested Lord Shiva to pardon Brahma and reinstate him. Lord Shiva pardoned Brahma and reinstated him for the creation of this universe. Further, Lord Shiva gave Shiva Upadesam / Gnanam to Brahma. Hence this place is being called "Thiru Meignanam".

There are 5 places considered as holy places as Mayanam. They are Kasi mayanam, Kachi (Kanchipuram) mayanam, Thirukadaiyur Mayanam, Kazhimayanam (Sirkazhi), Veezhi Nalur Mayanam. Kadavur Theertham alias Kasi Theertham is in the form of a well, near the temple in the midst of the field. It is believed that this well was created by Lord Shiva with water from Ganga to worship Lord Shiva by Markandeya Maharishi.

At that time, they noticed smoke coming out from a restaurant called 'Magiz Annam' owned by Ram Venkatraj at 4:00 am and informed the T. Nagar Fire Department.

It was revealed the short circuit was the reason.

Four trapped in residential power outage rescued

There is a three-story apartment building on Muthurangan Street, T. Nagar. Bhaskaran, 60, lives with his family on the second floor.

Wednesday, he went out with his family and returned home at 11:00 PM.

While traveling from the lower floor to the second floor on an electric scooter, it suddenly broke down and stopped halfway.

Immediately, Bhaskaran contacted the police control emergency helpline and reported that he was trapped in the electric shock.

The Mambalam fire brigade and police team arrived and safely rescued four people, including Bhaskaran, who were trapped in the electric shock.

Washing machine catches fire in Kodambakkam

Kannan, 60, is a resident of Sivan Kovil South Street, Kodambakkam. He turned on the washing machine at his house Thursday evening.

Then, a sudden electrical fault occurred and the washing machine caught fire. In this, the clothes and household appliances in the house were destroyed.

The Ashok Nagar fire department, which was informed, extinguished the fire.

No one was injured in the accident. The Vadapalani police are investigating the matter.

'Bike race' residents complaints

Pedestrians have alleged that they are afraid to walk along the Goods and Services Tax Office Road, which runs through the Saidapet Veterinary Hospital complex, at night due to a 'bike race' taking place.

After several complaints Traffic Police have been monitoring the area and have taken some preventive



measures.

The entrance gates of Anbazhagan Mansion, the Old Veterinary Hospital, and Panpettai Road will also be locked at night.

Lottery seller arrested

Velmurugan from Nellai was selling Kerala lottery ticket near a flower shop located in Vanniyar Street in K.K. Nagar.

It was revealed that external state lottery tickets sales were being conducted here.

A mobile phone was seized from him. During the investigation, it was found that Velmurugan, who was staying in a lodge near the Koyambedu market, wrote the numbers of out-of-state lottery tickets on a piece of paper and was checking the results through the mobile phone, involved in illegal lottery sales.

Actress files complaint against deceiving friend

A 30-year-old actress from Chennai has filed a complaint against her university friend Alexander Jawahar, 34, who allegedly cheated her by promising marriage and then rejecting her after eight years. The actress claims that Alexander told her he would divorce his abusive wife and marry her, but he is happily living with his family in Canada and has rejected her mobile calls.

Brother arrested for cutting younger brother in property dispute

The Vadapalani police have arrested a 41-year-old man named Ebenazer for attacking his younger brother Sasikumar with a knife in a property dispute. The incident occurred at a TASMALC liquor shop in Kodambakkam, and Sasikumar is receiving treatment for multiple injuries at the Royapettah government hospital.

Six people arrested for assaulting shopkeeper

The Kodambakkam police have arrested six people, including 19-year-old Amir Pasha and 18-year-old Pranglin, for assaulting a 41-year-old shopkeeper and stealing Rs. 30,000. The attackers had previously demanded money and threatened the shopkeeper, who had filed a complaint against them two years ago.

Teenager attacked over instagram mockery

A 15-year-old boy was attacked by seven people, including a 21-year-old man named Manoj, over a dispute on Instagram. The boy was injured in multiple places and admitted to the Royapettah Government Hospital. The Saidapet police are searching for the attackers, who are absconding.

Two youths arrested for breaking the bus window

Two youths named Sanjay, 19, from Vadapalani, and Muhammad Aasik Ameer, 20, were arrested for breaking the bus window in Kamarajar Salai, K K Nagar. According to the complaint from the driver of 12G bus. Police scanned CCTV Camera and arrested the drunken youth.

In the inquiry conducted with them, it was stated that they consumed alcohol at the TASMALC bar in the city and were standing intoxicated in the shop. They also mentioned that they threw a bottle and broke a glass in anger due to the bus driver repeated honking.

'Digital' board is installed at 500 stops

On the major routes of Chennai, three city buses run in a row at the same time. In addition, there is no regular bus service at specific times. As a result, passengers complained that they had to wait for up to an hour at the bus stops. Meanwhile, the urban transport corporation has decided to operate the buses smoothly, provide information to passengers, and implement an intelligent traffic system. In this regard, the installation of advanced GPS devices in city buses, setting up monitoring control rooms, and the installation of 'digital' boards at bus stops have



commenced.

The city traffic department officials have stated the following about this:

Under the smart traffic management plan, we are implementing a new system called 'City Bus System'. To provide information to passengers regarding bus arrival and departure times, LED digital boards will be installed at 500 stops and 71 bus stations.

Passengers can get real-time information about the arrival time of the bus through their mobile app.

In Kannadasan Street, T. Nagar, one portion of the road has been dug up for laying drainage pipe, a while before.

But till now action has not been taken for the same and the half work done is left unattempted. A properly laid cement concrete road is dug up on one side and hence the road could not be fully utilised thereby causing hindrance to the vehicle users.

Hence authorities to look into the matter immediately and cause to complete the work thereby avoiding unnecessary bumping on the road.

Encroachments removed in T Nagar

At least 150 eateries, fancy stalls, and merchandise stalls encroaching on the busy commercial streets of T Nagar were removed by the Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) on Wednesday. They included 52 shops on Ranganathan Street, 40 each from Natesan Street and Mambalam Market, and 20 shops from Rameshwaram Street.

Corporation officials said the crackdown followed complaints from road-users that the stalls extended about four feet on to the streets, reducing the walking space. The



pathway to Mambalam junction gets too crowded, creating a stampede-like situation, especially in the evening from 6 to 8.30 pm. 'Removal of these encroachments is a welcome move by GCC', said Nivash, a regular commuter from T Nagar.

'Ranganathan Road stretch was fully occupied by hawkers. There was no pathway for emergency vehicles such as ambulances or fire engines to pass through. We initially warned the hawkers to remove the encroachments and move to the vending zones allotted by GCC, but they were hesitant to leave', said C Eniyan, Zone 10 Executive Engineer.

Adhimula Perumal Temple under renovation

Century-old Adhilakshmi Sametha Adhimoola Perumal temple located near Vadapalani Murugan temple. The festival is presided over by Gajendra Varadaraja Perumal.

The renovation of the Adhimula Perumal Temple will include the construction of a stone mandapam in front of the shrine of the deity and mother, entrance gates on three sides of the temple, a decorative mandapam, a vehicle mandapam, and a yagasala.

Seal for the residential building that came in violation of regulations

In Kodambakkam Taluka, Ward No. 134, in West Mambalam, on Rajendraprasad First Street, a three-storey building containing 16 houses with parking is being constructed.

This building, which has been an old residence, is being newly constructed. A 'notice' has been issued by the municipality stating that it is being constructed in violation of municipal regulations.

Following this, the construction company appealed to the Tamil Nadu Housing and Urban Development Department and received a three-month extension.

In the situation where that deadline has passed, officials led by Assistant Executive Engineer Gnanavel and Assistant Engineer Thanalakshmi, with the protection of Ashok Nagar police, sealed the building.

Subsequently, the building was demolished and a new building with 20 classrooms on three floors was constructed at a cost of Rs. 4.81 crore. Similarly, the old perimeter wall of the school was demolished and a new one, 30 meters long, was built at a cost of 9.8 lakh rupees.

Chief Minister Stalin inaugurated this school building via video conference Wednesday.
