Temple, Thilathaipathi

This is the 175th Thevara Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam on the south side of river Kaveri and the 58th sthalam of Chozha Nadu. Now this place is called Sithalapathi/Sethalapathy on the banks of river Arasalaru. This place was called Madhimutham during ancient times.

In Periyapuranam Sekkizhar records that, Thirugnanasambandar came to this temple after worshiping Lord Shiva of Penu Perundurai. Moolavar : Sri Muktheeshwarar, Sri Mantharavaneswarar, Sri Madhimuktheswarar, Consort : Sri Swarna Valli, Sri Ambiga Porkodinayagi. Some of the salient features of this temple are... The temple faces east with a Rajagopuram. Rajagopuram was constructed in recent years with one side with normal Stucco images and other (inner) side only flat surface with paintings. Balipeedam and Rishabam are in front of the sanctum. Moolavar is of Swayambhu. In koshtam, Vinayagar, Dakshinamurthy, Lingothbavar, Brahma, and Ashtabhuja Durgai.

In praharam sannadhi for Vinayagar, Sri Valli Devasena Subramaniar, Gaja Lakshmi, Navagrahas, Chandran, Suriyan, Bhairavar, Nalvar, Nagar, Shiva Linga worshiped by Rama, Kasi Viswanathar, and Natarajar with Sivagami Manthara Vaneswarar is under the sthala vruksham. Sri Ram and Lakshman gave thila tarpanam in this temple. Sri Ram and Lakshman with Lingams are also in the prakaram. Maha Vishnu is found in three places in different postures in this temple.

The sanctum sanctorum consists of sanctum, antarala, and artha mandapam. There is a separate temple for Aadi Vinayagar. This Vinayagar is with a human face, instead of an elephant head face.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Thirugnanasambandar has sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple, the original temple might have existed before the 7th century and was later reconstructed as a stone temple during the Vijayanagara period and renovated by Nattukottai

Maha Kumbhabhishekam was conducted on 25th August 1999 and 08th July 2012.

LEGENDS

Since the river Arasalaru flows from north to south, this place is called "Utharavahini" and the temple is considered auspicious similar to Kasi.

Brahma was cursed by Lord Shiva for Brahma fell in love with Urvasi the dancer of Indraloka. To get rid of the curse Brahma came to this place and did a penance and worshiped Lord Shiva. Satisfied with the worship Lord Shiva, gave darshan and pardoned Brahma. He was also relieved from the curse.

In another legend, Lord Rama and his brother came to know about their father Dasaratha's demise. They performed "Thila Tharpanam" at this temple. Thilam is called as the name of Gingili oil. Tharpanam means to do the last rites for the departed soul of ancestors. Rama also did the tarpanam, ie the last rites of his loving bird Jatayu, which was killed by Ravana, when he was abducting Sita. Hence this place is called Thilatharpanapuri, which has corrupted to the present name of Sethalapathy, and Lord Shiva is called Muktheeswarar.

It is believed that Goddess Parvati, Maha Lakshmi, Brahma, Suriyan, Chandran, King Narchothi, an elephant, and a Lion worshiped Lord Shiva of this temple.

Pre-monsoon works underway in Mambalam canal

The greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) claims that maximum work as been finished for pre-monsoon works in the Mambalam Canal. However, local residents and traders have expressed strong doubt about the quality of work to prevent the flooding.

The GCC stated on its social media platform that restoration was nearly complete, with 4,200 metres of the 5,800 metre canal restored. The canal runs through Teynampet and Adyar zones.

Residents, however, remain unconvinced. Sathish a long time residents of Canal Bank road said that 'Work has continued for months, but we're unsure if it will mitigate floods. The truth will only be revealed when it rains'.



Overflowing sewage a major impediment

Overflowing sewage and contamination of drinking water is posing a health hazard to residents of Parangusapuram, Kodambakkam. Most of the residents say lack of proper drainage system is the main cause for the problem.

It is very common to see sewage stagnating on the road, which is because of poor construction of sewage chambers and frequent blockage in the pipeline, says Shanmuga Sundaram a long time resident. The stagnated sewage serves as a breeding ground for the mosquitoes.



Corpn to build and renovate bus shelters in Kodambakkam zone

The Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) has sanctioned the construction of new bus shelters and the refurbishment of existing ones in Kodambakkam (Zone X) The roofing work, estimated at 076.5 lakh, will be handled by a private agency through a tender process. The total project cost is 1.79 crore, with administrative sanction granted on June 28, 2025. In Kodambakkam, the worn-out bus terminus on Jones

Road, near Jawaharlal Street in West Saidapet, will be refurbished with tensile roofing at a cost of \$10.5 lakh. Orders for this work were issued on July 7, 2025. These initiatives aim to enhance public transportation infrastructure and provide better shelter and convenience to daily commuters across Chennai.

Double Decker buses to run again in Chennai

There is some fantastic news for the MTC bus travellers now in Chennai. Older generation Chennai residents would have enjoyed the amazing experience of travelling on double decker buses. Now, the current generation would also get this experience. Unbelievable!! The latest news is that the GCC or Greater Chennai Corporation has planned to resume double decker buses operations again in Chennai by the end of 2025. Under the National Clean Air Mission, MTC or metropolitan transport corporation in Chennai has been planning to operate 20 electric double decker buses once again in the first phase. On a private contract basis, arrangements have been made to operate these double decker buses in the city. The details about the contract would be announced soon.

It must be recalled that the double decker buses were first introduced in Chennai in the 70s and taken off the roads in the 80s. In the year 1997, double decker buses made a comeback again in Chennai and operated on 18A bus routes until 2008.

Rs. 25 lakhs seized at T. Nagar Post Office

Balasubramanian, who works as an assistant land surveyor in the Anchal department in Chennai, filed a complaint with the Pondy Bazaar police the day before Tuesday

It said, "The head office of the Pondy Bazaar, Abhi Bulla Road, has been recently audited. An officer working in that office has prepared false documents claiming to be the owners of goods for 50 sub-post offices and has misappropriated Rs. 25 lakhs. Therefore, action should be taken against him as per the law," it

Based on that complaint, the police have conducted an investigation.

Man falls to death from public toilet terrace

Krishnamoorthy, 52, a painter from Arcot Road, Vadapalani who lives in the top floor of a municipal toilet for over five years, died after falling from the toilet which is 25 feet height.

It is said that he was separated from his wife due to a disagreement and lived above the terrace of a public

toilet near the Corporation Higher Secondary School. Under the influence of alcohol, he was hanging out on top of a public toilet. He rolled over in his sleep and fell down in the early hours of the morning.

Krishnamurthy, who had sustained head injuries, was rescued by the locals and admitted to the Kilpauk Government Hospital. He died there early next day without responding to treatment. Vadapalani police are investigating.

Boy arrested for stealing

Police arrested a boy who stole Rs 7.20 lakh from the Kaliamman Temple in Ashok Nagar.

Head constable Arun and policeman Mahendran, who were on patrol duty on the 100-foot road in Vadapalani early Tuesday morning, went to a tea shop there. Seeing the patrol van the boy tried to leave the place. When the police interpreted and question him, he gave contradictory answers. When the suspicious police searched the boy, they found 30,000 rupees in his

The boy stated that he worked at a fish shop in Vanakaram and that the money was two months' salary. However, the police became suspicious because the mobile phone number the boy gave to contact his employer was incorrect.

Further, upon questioning him, he said that he had stolen money from a drunk person in Vadapalani. When the police went there, they found that no one was drunk

Meanwhile, the police control room received information that a mysterious box was lying in the tea shop where the boy was held, and the Vadapalani police went there and checked it. It contained seven lakh rupees

When asked at the store, the owner and employees said they were unaware of the box's arrival.

Subsequently, when the boy was questioned again, the boy admitted that he had stolen the money from the Bidari Kaliamman Temple Bureau on 100 Feet Road, Ashok Nagar.

Meanwhile, a complaint was filed on Tuesday at the KK Nagar police station that money from the temple had been stolen.

Subsequently, the Vadapalani police handed over the

boy and the seized Rs 7.20 lakh to the K.K. Nagar police.

As mosquito menace has increased to alarming proportions, most of us keep our windows and doors closed, he added.

Residents in the locality are forced to endure stagnant pools and a very few complain about sewage mixing with drinking water stored in sumps. Residents lament that during monsoon, sewage gets mixed with rainwater due to overflowing drainage channels. They say that repeated complaints to Metrowater and Chennai Corporation to clear the overflowing sewage have fallen on deaf ears.

We need a permanent solution, says Venkat a long resident of Rangarajapuram.

Aadhaar-based bio-metric renewal for students

The Education Department has issued a government order authorizing the department to undertake the task of updating Aadhaar biometrics for school students.

Students in the age group of 5-7 studying in all government, government-aided and private schools in Tamil Nadu are required to have their biometric details updated for the first time and students in the age group of 15-17 for the second time. In that case, biometric details of about 15 lakh students between the ages of 5-17 studying in the public education sector will have to be updated.

The Indian Ministry of Agriculture has been implementing the work of setting up a branch in the school and opening savings accounts for students since last year under a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

In addition, the education department has announced that it will be easier for students to complete the Aadhaar-based biometric re-registration process. The department has also announced the process for completing this task.

This work will be carried out by the civil servants. This work will be carried out in two phases from August to December. The education department has said that this will require the Aadhaar card biometric details of 15 lakh students to be updated.

A hassle-free six-pack home trip

The statement issued by the Hindu Samaya Charitable Trust Department states: In compliance with the notification of the Hindu Samaya Charitable Trusts Department Legislative Assembly for the financial year 2025-26, the six houses of Lord Muruga Perumal Thirupparangundram, Tiruchendur, Palani, Swamimalai, Tiruttani, and Palamudircholai have been invited to Senior citizens visit the shrines as a one-time visit without any restrictions.

Devotees wishing to undertake the spiritual journey must be Hindus and be between 60 and 70 years of age. If the annual income does not exceed Rs. 2 lakhs, an income certificate from the applicant should be attached. A copy of Aadhaar should be attached along with a medical certificate proving physical fitness.

Application forms for spiritual pilgrimage can be obtained directly from the respective Zonal Joint Commissionerate Offices or can be downloaded from the Hindu Religious and Charitable Trusts Department website www.hrce.tn.gov.in.

The completed application along with relevant documents should be submitted to the concerned Zonal Joint Commissioner's Office on or before 15th September. This is stated therein.

GCC is planning to develop areas under 2 flyovers

There are 2 huge flyovers present in busy places like T. Nagar and Alwarpet in Chennai.

Now, GCC is planning to develop the areas under these flyovers and an amount of Rs 7.5 cr would be spent on this. The main objective behind this is to improve the unused spaces in Chennai and provide better facilities to the public

It is now mentioned that at a cost of Rs 3.75 cr the area under the T. Nagar north Usman Road-Mahalingapuram Road junction flyover would be developed by the Chennai Corporation. Important piece of information is that in association with TNEB electric charging facilities for 2 wheelers would be set up. Not only this, dedicated parking facilities for 2 wheelers, 5 small shops to promote local business, purified drinking water facility, 8 toilets, trees, pants, decorative lights plus seating facilities for passengers, CCTV cameras, directional signs, walkways for the visually impaired, rainwater drainage and maintenance friendly ground floor would be set up.

As per some officials from the Chennai Corporation, the U turn, auto stand and ambulance parking under the flyover would continue to function without any disruption.

At a cost of Rs 3.75 cr, the space under the TTK Road- CP. Ramaswamy Road flyover would be developed by the Chennai Corporation.
