

Karuveli

This is the 180th Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam on the south side of river Kaveri and the 63rd sthalam of Chozha Nadu. Now this place is called Karuveli and also in the name of Lord Shiva as Sarguneswarapuram. During the ancient period, this place was called Karuvili and the temple was Kottidai, combined together called Karuvilikottaidai.

In Periyapuranam Sekkizhar records that Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal came to this temple after worshiping Lord Shiva of Thiruveezhimizhalai. Even though he didn't mention this temple in particular, but mentioned other temples on the way.

Moolavar: Sri Sarguna Natheswarar, Sri Sarguneswarar, Consort: Sri Sarvanga Nayagi Some of the salient features of this temple are......
The temple faces east with an entrance arch on the roadside. Rishabam is in a mandapam before the 3-Tier Rajagopuram. Moolavar is of Swayambhu. In Koshtam, Narthana Vinayagar, Dakshinamurthy, Bhairavar, Brahma, Arthanareeswarar, and Durgai. In praharam Vinayagar, Sri Valli Devasena Subramaniar, Chandikeswarar, Nalvar, and two kings. Goddess Simha Vahini and Hanuman as Sanjeevi Anjaneyar near the Ambal sannathi.

ARCHITECTURE

Ambal is in a separate temple with a sanctum sanctorum, artha mandapam, and a Vimana over the sanctum. The main temple consists of sanctum sanctorum, antarala, and artha mandapam. The Sanctum Sanctorum is on a pada banda adhistanam with 3 patta kumudam. Prastaram consists of Valapi, kapotam and Viyyalavari. A 2-tier nagara - vesara vimanam is on the sanctum and sikaram is of vesara style. Koshtas are in the greevam only.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal has sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple, the original temple might have existed before the 7th century. The same was reconstructed as a stone temple during the Chozha period and further extended by

Vijayanagara/Marathas and Nattukottai Nagarathars. The inscriptions recorded from this temple belong to the latter Chozhas, Rajathirajan-II, and Rajendran. Rajarajan-II's 4th reign year inscription records this place was under Uyyakondar Valanattu Vennattu Kulothunga Chozha Nallur Kottidai.

Maha Kumbhabhishekam was conducted during recent years on 27th March 1997, 14th July 2008 and 30th June 2017.

LEGENDS

Ma Parvati went to attend the Yagna conducted by Dakshan, without the permission of Lord Shiva. There She cursed the Yagna, Dakshan, and the Participants. Since she went without the permission of Lord Shiva, came to this place and did a penance to reunite with Lord Shiva. It is believed that Ma Parvati presented her as a pleasing and beautiful form to Lord Shiva. Hence Ma Parvati is called Sarvanga Sundari. It is believed that Lord Shiva danced here as "Kodukotti" and hence place obtained the name Kottidai. Yama also worshiped Lord Shiva to get relief from his sins.

In a legend, the king named Sargunan was an ardent devotee of Lord Shiva. He came to this place and worshiped Lord Shiva. He attained Mukti ie freed from the cycle of birth and rebirth. Hence this place is called Karu + Illai – Karuvili (Karu – fetus, Illai – no). Hence Lord Shiva is called Sri Sarguna Nathar - Lord with good qualities.

A student Praveen, 27, from Vadapalani, was arrested for possession of methamphetamine. He revealed that he was working as a troupe dancer in the cinema industry.

It was also revealed that he had purchased drugs from his college friend Yuvraj, 27, and sold them to many people in the film industry.

"You don't need to come to the bank, I'll send an employee to help," Swaminathan said.

He sent a bank teller named Prasad to Sulaiman's house, where he collected 162 sovereigns of jewelry and a signature on a bank form given by Sulaiman.

When I later contacted Swaminathan to ask for money, he delayed, saying, "The server is not working; auditing

Suspecting his words, Sulaiman went to the bank to investigate. At that time, it was discovered that Swaminathan had been 'suspended' for engaging in money laundering.

The Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority (CMDA) is renovating the bus stand at T. Nagar one of the busiest shopping places for all commodities at a cost of `254 crore with a five-storey commercial complex, places for bus crew to take rest, hotels and a library. Tree cut down for SWD work





A old Baniyan tree in Alagriswamy Salai, KK Nagar was cut down by GCC for storm water work.

Apart from this GCC is pruning trees in the area. In the process, they also felled numerous trees, some more than 100 years old.

Residents say previously branches would be cut on the first day, and the following day, the whole tree would be cut and the debris cleared. Within 24 hours, there would be no sign of the tree. However, as residents started opposing this, trees are now being cut after 11 pm, they allege.

"The SWDs are very close to the roots of the trees. The trees are in so much distress due to the cement. It will take at least 100 more years for the trees to regrow, and the likelihood is very low because the cement and bitumen won't allow them to grow. KK Ramaswamy Salai, Munuswamy Salai and Lakshmana Swamy Salai are among the areas that lost most of their green cover," said K Joseph, a landscaping expert and long-time resident of KK Nagar.

The older trees that have been chopped include raintree, neemtree, Poovarasan tree, Bodhi tree, monkey pod, copper pod and Lannea coromandelica, which can sprout new leaves and start growing even if a mere two feet of the main trunk is left and if the roots aren't uprooted or damaged. According to experts, a fully-grown tree of these species gives at least 110 kg of oxygen each year.

"The felling of trees started in the beginning of July and there seems to be no end to it. When we chop a tree, we rarely worry about the bird and mammalian life we damage, and don't even bother to realise that these life forms play a big and major role in sustaining the ecosystem for mankind. Vertical pits may be a better option than horizontal SWDs, so more trees are not damaged," said PS Karthikeyan, a botanist.

'Chennai One' ticket lasts only 3 hours

†Electric train tickets purchased through the Chennai One app must be used within three hours,' Southern Railway has said. In this regard, the Southern Railway has issued a statement: The Tamil Nadu government launched the 'Chennai One' app on the 22nd to facilitate travel by electric train, metro, city bus, auto and taxi in the suburbs of Chennai. With this app, you can buy tickets for suburban electric trains and travel. Passengers can use this app just like the existing UTS app.

There is no change in suburban train fares. 'AC' electric train tickets cannot be purchased. During ticket verification, passengers will have to show their tickets through the 'Show Original Train Ticket' page. Tickets cannot be cancelled. These tickets must be used within three hours of purchase. This is what it says.

When contacted, a corporation official said only weak trees are being felled, and branches of big trees are being cut. "We have been getting complaints from residents, but only weak trees are being cut so no more mishaps happen," the official said, and refused to comment on the felling of 100-year-old trees in the area. One of the officials said that, maximum we try to avoid cutting trees for SWD work.
