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Voice of GOD



Sri Agnipureeswarar Temple, Anniyur

This is the 179th Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam on the south side of river Cauvery and the 62nd Sthalam of Chozha Nadu. The temple is on the banks of river Arasalaru.

In Periyapuram Sekkizhar records that Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal came to this temple after worshipping Lord Shiva of Thiruveezhimizhalai. Even though he didn't mention this temple in particular, but mentioned other temples on the way.

Moolavar : Sri Agnipureeswarar, Sri Agneeswarar, Consort : Sri Gowripavathy

Some of the salient features of this temple are.....

The temple faces east with a two-tier Rajagopuram. A balipeedam and a Rishabam are after the entrance of Rajagopuram. In koshtam Dakshinamurthy, Lingothbavar, Brahma, and Durgai.

In prakaram Vinayagar, Sri Valli Devasena Subramaniam, Nalvar, Shiva Lingas, Bhairavar, Suriyan, Chandran, Saneeswarar and Two Chandikeswarar. Sthala puranam bas-relief is on the out side mandapam wall. In praharam Somaskandar and Natarajar.

Ambal is in a separate Sannadhi. Ambal is small and Dwarapalakas are in stone.

ARCHITECTURE

The temple consists of sanctum sanctorum, antarala, artha mandapam and a open mukha mandapam. A Vesara vimana is on the sanctum.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal has sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple the original temple might have existed before the 7th Century. Later the same was reconstructed as a stone temple during the Chozha period and further extended/maintained during the Vijayanagara/Maratha period and Nattukottai Nagarathars. Maha kumbhabhishekam was conducted on 21st August 2002.

LEGENDS

It is believed that Brahma, Agni, Sage Agasthiyar, Sanathkumarar, and Sanathanar worshiped Lord Shiva of this temple.

In another legend, Dkashan conducted a Yagna for which Maha Vishnu, Brahma, Ashtadikpalakas, and Pancha Bhutas including Agni and Devas attended. Lord Shiva was not invited for the same. When asked by Ma Parvati as Dakshayani, Dakshan didn't give a proper response. Angered Lord Shiva sent Veerabhadra and Ma Kali to destroy the Yagna.

Veerabhadra killed Daksha by cutting his head later replaced with a goat's head. The participants of Yagna were cursed and punished. In that, Agni was also cursed and lost his hands and tongue. He came to this place to worship Lord Shiva with Vanni's leaves and was relieved from the curse, restoring his hands and tongue. Hence Lord Shiva is called Agneeswarar. Agni also requested Lord Shiva to bless the devotees who are suffering from deceases related to "ushnam - Heat". The place was called Vanniyur (Vanni + oor) and was corrupted to the present name of Anniyur.

Parihara sthalam for Vastu and it is believed that blood pressure and heat (ushnam) related ailments will be cured if one takes a bath in Agni theertham and worships Lord Shiva. The 8 temples around this place are considered as Ashtadikpalakas, in which Anniyur is also one of them. It is auspicious to worship all these eight temples.

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Police take action to collect fine amounts from insurance companies

The amount of unpaid fines for vehicles involved in violations has exceeded 300 crores. As a result, the police in Chennai have implemented a new procedure that will require drivers to pay a fine before they can renew their vehicle insurance.

As the number of vehicles in Chennai increases, so do the number of traffic violations. The police are imposing fines on drivers who violate the rules.

In addition to the direct fine system, sophisticated surveillance cameras are installed at various locations to monitor and fine motorists who violate the rules.

Fines are being imposed for violations including speeding, ignoring signals, and not wearing a helmet. This fine can be paid through the device available at the traffic police, through Paytm, the app, or through the post office. However, many motorists have been not paying fines for years.

To collect this fine, advice is being provided through the 'call center' staff set up in each Assistant Transport Commissioner's office.

However, since many people are not willing to pay the fines, more than 300 crore rupees of fines are pending. In this situation, the Chennai Police have implemented a new procedure as a crackdown to prevent violations.

It has been made mandatory to pay insurance for vehicles. All types of insurance companies are connected to the app and website called 'Parivahan'.

On the insurance company's online page, you need to enter the vehicle number and renew the insurance. During the renewal, if the fine amount for the concerned vehicle is not paid, you will be advised to pay it immediately.

Insurance can only be renewed by paying the outstanding penalty amount.

Stop nailing trees

With electric poles, trees and transformer boxes being used for advertisements, it seems that many unorganised players have got a free platform for promotion purposes. One example is in the Kuppaswamy Street, T Nagar. Often we observe postcards, placards, flute boards being nailed or stapled on trees, crucifying the remnants of beauty in the city today. In fact, Section VI of Advertisement By-laws 2006, clearly states that no person shall display posters, nail, attach or fix posters, flex boards, cut outs on any tree, electric poles or telephone poles in the city. In spite of the law being so precise, this menace is rampant in the city.



Flyover works progressing at Teynampet–Saidapet stretch



The construction of the 3.20 km long four-lane elevated flyover on Anna Salai, between Teynampet and Saidapet, is progressing steadily. The project, launched by Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on January 19, 2024, is being executed at an estimated cost of ₹621 crore to ease traffic congestion along the busy corridor. Minister for Public Works, Highways and Minor Ports, A.V. Velu, recently inspected the project site. With 40 percent of the work completed, the Minister directed officials

to expedite the foundation, micro-piling, geo synthetic layering, and welding works in the metro tunnel and other sections. He emphasized the need to complete foundation works before the onset of the monsoon season. He also instructed officials from the Traffic Police, Electricity Board, GCC, Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board, and the Forest Department to coordinate at the work sites to ensure smooth progress without causing inconvenience to the public.

One of the busiest street in Mambalam Station Road is a builder construct a building in this street blocks partially the road by keeping hollow block bricks. This is not only causes inconvenience to motorists and commuters. Will the concern officials take action against the illegal occupation.

Taps dry at dhobi ghat



Despite Chennai's surplus water storage, taps remain dry at Saidapet's Dhobikhana, the city's second-largest dhobi ghat, crippling the livelihoods of 250 families who wash nearly 9,000 clothes a day. Damaged water tanks, delayed metro, water lorries, and unusable restrooms have pushed families to rent water and wade through sewage to keep their work going.

'Enough water is a basic requirement for clean service', said a resident. 'We're ready to pay for a steady supply, but we spend thousands renting water and land for drying. I even fetch water from outside just to use the toilet'.

Previously, three Sintex tanks holding 9,000 litres met daily needs, but with tanks damaged and metrowater lorries skipping deliveries for up to five days a month, scarcity worsened.

Kodambakkam (Zone 10) chairman M Krishna Moorthy said, we're working to modernise restrooms, repair damaged water tanks, and provide direct metrowater connections to reduce dependency on lorries. I will raise these issues with minister Ma Subramanian for urgent solutions'.



Changes to Metro Rail service from the 15th

Due to the ongoing second phase of construction work above the Vadapalani Metro Station, transport services on the Green Line have been diverted.

The metro rail service running from Koyambedu to Ashok Nagar will be temporarily rerouted from the 15th to the 19th. From 5:00 am to 6:00 am, the metro trains will run at an interval of 14 minutes between Parangimalai - Ashok Nagar Metro Station; 14 minutes between Airport and Ashok Nagar; and seven minutes between Central and Koyambedu.

Metro rail service from Koyambedu to Ashok Nagar will be temporarily suspended. For the convenience of passengers during this time, special connecting buses will be operated every 10 minutes between 5:00 AM and 6:00 AM in the Koyambedu and Ashok Nagar metro rail station areas. Metro rail services will operate as usual from 6:00 AM.

Bricklayer seriously injured

Ilangovan, a bricklayer from Masudi Street, Aminjikarai, was working on repairing the roof of a house in the Choolaimedu area Thursday evening. He suffered a spinal cord fracture after tripping and falling from a height of 15 feet. He has been admitted to the intensive care unit of the Kilpauk Government Hospital.

Fire officer arrested for accepting a bribe

Aziz, a resident of Valasaravakkam, applied online for a fire department certificate to open a new beauty salon in Ramapuram.

To grant permission for this, Ramapuram Fire Station Officer Elangovan demanded a bribe of Rs. 25,000; later, after bargaining, the amount was reduced to Rs. 10,000. Aziz, who did not want to pay a bribe, filed a complaint with the Chennai Anti-Corruption and Vigilance Department police. Aziz, who was told by Officer Ilango that the chemical-coated currency notes given by the police were handed over to firefighter Munusamy, was caught red-handed by the anti-corruption police who were hiding there.

After investigation, the Anti-Corruption Police arrested both Munusamy and Officer Elangovan.

Bullet Train proposed between Hyderabad and Chennai

Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy has proposed introducing a bullet train service from Shamshabad, near Hyderabad, to Chennai. Shamshabad is home to the Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, making it a key transport hub. During a meeting with officials, the Chief Minister reviewed pending railway projects and discussed new proposals to meet future transport needs. He supported the idea of a railway line connecting the proposed 'Bharat Future City' near Hyderabad to Machilipatnam port in Andhra Pradesh via Amaravati, the state's capital. Reddy also instructed officials to prepare fresh proposals for new railway lines and stressed the importance of a 'Regional Ring Rail' around Hyderabad, to complement the planned Regional Ring Road (RRR).

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SWD work causes traffic congestion



Choolaimedu is one of the areas in Chennai that has the most residential areas and various commercial complexes situated. It is very thick in population. The area is surrounded by Arumbakkam, MMDA Colony, Aminjikarai and Vadapalani. There are more than 200 streets in Choolaimedu.

The work of establishing rainwater drainage in various areas including the Chennai Metro, Bhajanai Kovil Street, there is a traffic jam on the roads there, and motorists are facing severe difficulties during peak hours. Many people have demanded that the work be completed quickly.

Meanwhile, Choolaimedu has been experiencing traffic congestion for the past few months. The main reason for this is the ongoing stormwater drainage works at various places.

The work of SWD has been going on past 6 months, says a resident of Abdullah Street. Work is underway at many places including Anna Nedumpathai in Choolaimedu, Bhajanai Koyil Road, Vada Akaramsala, and Periyarpathai.

Similarly, the work of installing rainwater drainage in the area adjacent to the entrance of Anna Nedumpathai, namely Kannagi Road and Andavar Road, is underway. Similarly, work has begun on the road leading to Bhajanai Kovil via Kalyana Raman Street at the entrance of Kalyana Raman Street. Due to this, Bhajanai Kovil Street has been completely cut off. Due to the road being cut off, motorists are currently forced to travel via the Anna Nedumpada.

Due to this, there is heavy traffic congestion on the

Anna Nedumpathai Road. Similarly, work on the Periyar Bridge is progressing slowly. To properly handle these tasks, the traffic police should be put on duty.
