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Illegal shops occupying sidewalks issued notice

Pedestrians are struggling to walk due to shops occupying sidewalks throughout Chennai city. The corporation, which had been watching the encroachment until now, has suddenly woken up and ordered the removal of sidewalk shops. It has also ordered the area engineers to take legal action if the encroachment continues. In India, according to the 'Street Vendors' Livelihood and Regulation Act - 2014', vendors can operate on roadsides with the permission of the respective local bodies.

However, goods should only be sold on a cart; a shop should not be set up permanently in one location. According to a court order, only shops for the livelihood of the differently-abled can be set up permanently in one location.

Awareness on Hereditary Cancer

Apollo Cancer Centre Chennai recently treated a remarkable case of familial clustering where four members of a single family from Guwahati, spanning two generations, were diagnosed with cancers linked to Lynch syndrome. The mother, Mrs Namita Dey, was diagnosed with ovarian cancer at 50 years and treated in 2011, while her daughter, Mrs Deepa Ghosh, was diagnosed with ovarian cancer at 26 years and treated in 2012. More recently, her other two children, Mrs Shikha Sarkar and Mathura Nath Dey, both diagnosed at 40 years, were treated in 2024 for right colon cancer. All four are currently doing well, underscoring how timely intervention and surgical care can change treatment outcomes to lead a better-quality life.

The patient said, 'when cancer struck not just one but four of us in our family, it felt overwhelming and frightening. But our Doctors at Apollo Cancer Centres, helped us, not just with treatment, but guidance and compassion at every step. Today, we are all doing well, and we carry hope instead of fear. It has shown me that even when cancer runs in families, timely care can truly change the story'.

Slow work in progress



The people of Choolaimed and Arumbakkam areas are suffering as the work on the Coovam flyover is progressing at a snail's pace.

The Virugambakkam canal runs through Choolaimedu Pari Street near Arumbakkam, ward 106-107 under Anna Nagar zone. This canal, which begins at Nelkondram, passes through Arumbakkam, Choolaimedu, MMDA Colony and merges into the Aminikarai Koovam. For the past few months, work has been underway to demolish the old viaduct and build a new one on this canal that runs along Tamilar Street in

Choolaimedu, Padmanabha Nagar. Even though the work has been going on for several months, people are suffering greatly as it is progressing at a snail's pace.

Of these, 80 percent of the work on the Choolaimedu Mata Kovil Street Coovam flyover has been completed. Similarly, there is no progress on the Tamilar Street Coovam flyover work.

As the main road leading to MMDA Colony and Arumbakkam has been closed for this work, the people of Arumbakkam and Choolaimedu have to travel several kilometers around.

During the rainy season, the flow of water in this canal is obstructed, leading to flooding in the area. They said this.



Clear garbage dump

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Successful angioplasty on 95 year old patient

Promed Hospital conducted a successful angioplasty on a 95 year old patient. He is one of the oldest patient in Asia to undergo such a complex cardiac intervention. The cardiac team, led by Dr Arun Kalyanasundaram, Director & Head of Cardiology, undertook a highly complex yet precisely planned multi-vessel percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI).

To ensure maximum safety during this high-risk procedure, doctors, utilized the impella CP, a miniature heart pump that temporarily supports cardiac function. Intravascular Ultrasound (IVUS) imaging provided real-time, high-definition visuals to guide the precise stent placement.

Pet animal survey from November

Greater Chennai Corporation will launch a door-to-door survey for the enumeration of pet animals under its jurisdiction from November. According to sources that the survey was planned because the civic body did not have proper data on the pets, and the vaccination status. The trained staff will be sent door-to-door to carry out surveys.

They will check if the pets have received the antirabies vaccination and if they are licensed. They will collect the age of the animal, date of birth and breed. Pet-owners will be instructed and guided on the need to vaccinate their pets against rabies, obtaining a licence starting from that date, the official said.

Youth arrested for stealing from tenant

The Vadapalani police arrested Arun Kumar house owner who allegedly stole valuables from the tenant of his house. According to the tenant Ramesh the stolen articles are golden ornaments and few cash, he continued when the family was away for his hometown along with his family and returned on Tuesday (October 7) night. As there were no signs on the front door to indicate a forced entry, the family did not suspect anything. However, when they went inside, Ramesh (tenant) noticed that his house was burgled.

He then filed a police complaint, based on which the police collected the CCTV footage from the neighbourhood and zeroed in on the suspect and the owner was arrested.

Two arrested in drug possession case

The Choolaimedu police arrested four people, Pratap, 29, Janardhanan, 27, Poornasandran, 21, and Abdulwasim, 22, in connection with the possession of drugs on further investigation.

Police arrested two more persons on Tuesday in the Choolaimedu area in connection with a drug possession case.

The narcotic pills and packages of ganja was seized worth of Rs 2.65 lakh.

Commissioner Arun personally called the 29 police officers and policemen who arrested the criminals in this case Tuesday and rewarded them.

Grocery store owner arrested for sexually harassing kid

Immanuel Moses (49) a grocery store owner in Vadapalani harassed sexually a five year old kid. The incident occurred when the girl had gone alone to the store to buy provisions on Sunday. According to sources the suspect, Immanuel Moses (49), allegedly touched the child inappropriately, prompting her to scream for help on hearing her scream. Residents immediately rushed to her aid, and restrained Moses and informed police. The accused has been booked under Pcoso Act. He was produced before a magistrate and remanded in judicial custody.

Cyber police handed handed over recovered money

The Cyber Crime Police are receiving complaints every day even though many awareness programmes are made for public. CCP have solved many cases and recovered money and was handed over to public recently Rs.1.27 cr.

Cybercrime police said: A large number of people filed complaints at the Central Crime Branch Cybercrime Police Station last September. Out of these, 46 petitions were investigated and Rs 56.12 lakhs were recovered.

A total of 121 complainants from all over Chennai have been dealt with and Rs. 1.27 crore has been recovered and handed over to the rightful owners.

So far this year, Rs 21.69 crore has been recovered and handed over to the rightful owners. This was stated by the police.

Ganja seized; four arrested

Police on Sunday arrested four men in Choolaimedu and seized 1.5 kg ganja, 260 grams of OG ganja, 10 ml of ganja oil and eight MDMA tablets. The arrests were made following a raid held in Kamala Nehru Nagar. Officials also seized six mobile phones, five weighing machines, a sum of `2.65 lakh and a two-wheeler.

The arrested persons were identified as Pratap, Janarthanan (27), Poornachandran (21) and Abdul Wasim (22). Investigations revealed that Pratap was running a YouTube channel, Janarthanan worked in a

software firm in Bengaluru, Poornachandran was a BBA student and Abdul Wasim was a restaurant manager.



More buses for Deepavali rush

Transport minister S.S. Sivasankar on Monday announced that the government will operate a total of 20,378 buses from October 16 to 19 to meet the rush of people who will go to their native places for Deepavali.

A large number of people are expected to leave for their native places since Deepavali falls on Monday. All the buses going to Madurai, Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Salem, Tiruchy, Coimbatore, Kumbakonam, Thanjavur, Cuddalore, Puducherry, Chidambaram through the Chennai-Tiruchy national highway would start from the Kilambakkam bus terminus.

The buses going to Vandavasi, Polur and Tiruvannamalai will start from the MTC bus stand in Kilambakkam. Buses going through the East Coast Road besides those going to Bengaluru, Vellore, Kanchipuram and Tiruttani would be operated from Koyambedu. From Madhavaram terminus, buses going to Andhra, Ponneri and Oothukottai besides the ordinary services to Tiruchi, Salem, Kumbakonam and Thiruvannamalai would be operated.

Request to add additional coaches to trains running for Diwali

Southern Railway Works Advisory Committee member Sivasundaram has urged that additional coaches be added to trains operating to southern districts during the Diwali festival.

The festival of Diwali will be celebrated on the 20th. For this reason, ticket sales for the Pandian, Kanyakumari, Pothikai, Muthu Nagar, Ananthapuri, and Silambu express trains operating from Chennai to the southern districts were sold out within two minutes of the start.

There are more than 200 people on the waiting list on all trains. Therefore, additional coaches need to be added to all trains.

In the Diwali special announcement, many trains are also running from Chengalpattu at 12:00 midnight. This will not benefit those traveling from Chennai to the southern districts.

Therefore, the Nagercoil, Mahal and Bodinayakkanur special trains, which are operated three days a week, should be operated daily. The special trains to be announced from now on should be operated from Egmore, the press release said.
