Tenant arrested for slashing landlord's son

A tenant Bhaskaran 37, slashed land lords son on the back in Saligramam. The reason behind is that tenant Bhaskaran use to drink daily and make nuisance every day. In this scenario the land lord Ganesh Gopal, 45, a resident of Gandhi Nagar, Saligramam, asked him vacate the house. And more over he has not paid the rent properly. On confronting this he slashed the boy. Virugambakkam police arrested tenant Bhaskaran and investigation on.

Land grabbing three arrested

Abdul Rahman, 33, a resident of Munusamy Street, Saligramam, filed a police complaint. My parents have a 2,280 sqft plot of land with a building on two streets in Saligramam. After the death of their parents, the land was seized by their uncle Mohammad Kasim, aunt Sariba Banu, and their uncle's son Pir Mohammad using forged documents.

The Central Crime Branch police arrested three relatives in connection with the case of grabbing two plots of land worth four crore rupees in Saligramam.

They have prepared fake documents claiming that I sold it for Rs 80 lakh. Legal action should be taken against those who have snatched away my property worth Rs 4 crore.

He had stated this in the complaint. The Central Crime Branch police registered a case and arrested Mohammad Kasim, 54, Sariba Banu, 41, and Pir Mohammad, 25, from Saligramam, who were involved in the fraud, Tuesday.

Two absconding suspects arrested

Virugambakkam Police arrested two people who were absconding for attempt to murder case.

Accordingly, Sivaraman, 25, from Tuticorin district, was arrested by the Virugambakkam police Tuesday. Similarly, the K K Nagar police also arrested

Sarathkumar, 29, from Ashok Nagar, who had absconded without appearing in court in a murder attempt case that took place within the limits of the K K Nagar police station in 2021.

He absconded after failing to appear for the hearing at the Saidapet court. Following this, the court issued an arrest warrant on the 25th of last month.

5 sovereign snatched police on hunt

Kausalya, 70, a elderly person and a resident of Gajalakshmi Nagar, near Kundrathur. She went for a walk on Bhajanai Kovil Street in the same area the day before Tuesday evening.

At that time, a person who approached the elderly person asking for address and within minutes he snatched the gold chain and escaped in a bike. Kundrathur police rushed to the scene, and collected camera footage and are searching for the culprit.

Drug trafficker held for meth possession

A person convicted earlier for drug trafficking was arrested with a woman for possession of methamphetamine was arrested by the Nungambakkam police.

The arrested were Warren Craig Ghani (29) of Kelambakkam, Tahira Nihal (26) of Choolaimedu, Lakshmi Narasima Rao (27) of Ashok Nagar and Sriram (28) of Vadapalani.

Based on a tip-off about the movement of synthetic drugs within Nungambakkam police limits, the ANIU (Anti-Narcotics Intelligence Unit) coordinated with the local police and maintained vigil at Lakshmanan Street in Mahalingapuram on Sunday morning.

The police noticed the four accused and rounded them up. As they gave evasive replies, police searched their belongings and found 45.5 grams of methamphetamine, 190 grams of OG ganja, five LSD stamps, 2.3 grams of MDMA tablets, and 18 grams of hashish oil. They were arrested and remanded in judicial custody.

Student hangs denied permission to write exam

Vasudevan, 18, a resident of Sivan Kovil Street, Kodambakkam. He was studying in the second year of B.A. at a private college in Ramapuram.

He was denied permission to write an exam for using a mobile phone.

He took his mobile phone to the exam hall. The Professor, confiscated the mobile phone and sent him home without allowing him to write the exam. The student got depressed and went on suicide.

In this situation, Vasudevan's mother Geetha went to the temple the evening before Saturday and returned home at night. At that time, it was revealed that Vasudevan had committed suicide by hanging himself at home.

The Kodambakkam police, who received the information, registered a case and sent the student's body to the K.K. Nagar ESI Hospital.

Vasudevan's mother Geetha filed a complaint with the police:

My son had his semester exam on the 6th. His class coordinator, Smt., called me on my mobile phone and told me that Vasudevan was very depressed and that she was sending him home with two students.

As soon as he got home, he made a video call and asked me to show him around. When I asked him what happened, Vasudevan said that he was denied permission to write the exam because he was using his mobile phone in the exam room and was made to sit alone.

I don't know what happened there, to the point where they left my son alone and took his own life.

While the lecturer was speaking, Srimati repeatedly advised, 'Don't ask him anything; watch him carefully.' I wonder what the reason for that is.

Therefore, the college and the lecturer, Mrs., are responsible for my son's death. Therefore, legal action should be taken against them.

This is what he said in the complaint. The police are investigating the matter.

Money stolen from 'Amma' restaurant

Amma Restaurant is operating on Arunachalam Road, Saligramam. The day before yesterday, the sales ended and the restaurant was closed and left.

When Amma Canteen opened as usual morning, it was revealed that Rs. 5,000, the two-day collection money from Amma Canteen, had been stolen.

Virugambakkam police are investigating.

Introduction of e-passport in India - How to get it? What are the benefits?

E-passport has been introduced to modernize passports in India. It will look like a regular passport, but the radio frequency identification chip (RFID) and antenna on the back of the card will be affected. This chip will contain personal details including name and address, as well as biometric details including fingerprints and facial images. On the front cover of the e-passport, there is a small gold-colored code under the word "PASSPORT". This can be used to identify the e-passport.

Who can apply?

Any Indian citizen who is eligible to apply for a regular passport can apply for an e-passport. You can apply at the nearest Passport Seva Kendras (PSK) and Post Office Passport Seva Kendras (POPSK). How to get one?

Just like applying for a regular passport, you need to fill out an application form, pay the fee, and book an appointment for an interview at the passport office. During that meeting, biometric data such as fingerprints



and photographs will be recorded.

After that, the e-passport will be sent to the address of the person concerned after the processing is completed.

If you have recently provided biometric details for a regular passport, you will not be asked for these details when applying for an e-passport.

What are the benefits?

Since the information is stored digitally, it cannot be stolen, damaged, or forged. Furthermore, this chip can be easily scanned at airports and officials can verify passenger details. This will reduce the waiting time for travel. Moreover, it is recognized in various countries worldwide

Collector warns of men driving pink autos

Thennai Collector Rashmi Siddharth Jagade has said that pink autos, which are meant to be driven only by women, will be confiscated if driven by men. Chief Minister Stalin launched the 'Pink Auto' scheme, operated by women for women, to ensure the safety of

Under this scheme, more than 200 women in Chennai have been provided with autos that run on compressed natural gas (CNG).

The main objective of the project is to have women drivers operate autos. However, there have been allegations that men are often the drivers of the pink autos. Statement issued by Chennai Collector Rashmi Siddharth Jagade: Following a complaint that men were driving pink autos, social welfare officials conducted an investigation for a few days. It was found that men were driving pink autos.

Social welfare officials warned that action would be taken by the RTO if men drive pink autos in violation of the rules.

Councillors meeting held

The Kodambakkam Zonal Committee meeting, chaired by its chairman Krishnamoorthy, was held at the Zonal Office. The councilors spoke as follows: Kannan, DMK, 138th Ward: Elections are coming up. Only if we complete the work quickly, we will be able to meet the people. If we win by winning votes, it means that you, the officials, have acted correctly

Ravi Shankar, DMK, 129th Ward: It seems like the rain has run away from us because we were prepared for the rainy season. In areas including Virugambakkam and Vadapalani, there are a large number of elderly people living along the roads. Arrangements should be made to shift them to old age homes. There is no space in the ward to dump garbage including sofas and mattresses collected from house to house; this should be created. Voter registration is slow. Steps should be taken to complete it quickly within the specified time.

Dhanasekar, DMK, 137th Ward: Due to water supply and sewerage work, it was not possible to construct a road on 11th Street in Choolaipallam, MGR Nagar. Now that the work has been completed and the road has been handed over, an estimate needs to be prepared to construct the road quickly.

Uma Anand, BJP, 134th Ward: Vehicles are parked on both sides, occupying 20 - 25 feet of the road in West Mambalam. This causes congestion. The government announced to provide RO units in all schools. But it did not allocate funds to maintain it.

Stella, DMK, 128th Ward: There has been an increase in roadside shops in the ward. Someone is charging money for them. It should be controlled. The lighting is poor. It needs to be replaced. A contract has been awarded to maintain the park, but no staff has been appointed for the work.

Sridhar, DMK, 140th Ward: The work to improve 'Amma' Park on behalf of CMDA was started last July. But the work has not been done. The opposition parties are accusing us of stopping the work. Thus they spoke. At the meeting, 20 resolutions were passed.



Consumers can file complaints if overcharged

A mid growing complaints over unusually high electricity bills across Tamil Nadu, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board (TNEB) has assured consumers that the issue will be addressed promptly through both online and offline complaint mechanisms.

Electricity bills in the state are collected once every two months, with 100 units offered free of cost and

subsidised rates for up to 200 units. However, consumers using over 300 to 350 units fall under higher tariff slabs. Officials explained that meter reading delays of 3 to 6 days in some areas have led to additional units being counted, resulting in

inflated bills during the September and November cycles.

TNEB has advised affected consumers to file complaints through the official website www.tangedco.gov.in under the "Consumer Grievance" section, or by contacting the helpline 1912. Complaints can also be made in person at the respective division offices. To ensure speedy resolution, special officers have been appointed in every zone, and the Board has warned of strict action against employees responsible for billing errors.

Officials have urged the public to check their bills carefully and report any discrepancies without delay to avoid overpayment and ensure accurate consumption records.

Abandoned vehicles a curse

A bandoned vehicles have made a comeback in Sankarapuram First Street, Choolaimedu, as the Chennai Corporation has not held any drive to remove them. Abandoned vehicles have occupied public spaces leaving little or no room for residents to walk. These ignored vehicles are a threat to society.

Illegal parking is the very biggest problem, residents opine. Many seized mobikes still lie unclaimed in Choolaimedu police station, they added.

With no drives to remove abandoned vehicles,



more mobikes, autorickshaws continue to be abandoned. This also encourage parking in public spaces in nearby streets, says Gunasekar, a long time resident. Unless there is accounting and proper disposal of older vehicles, new ones should not be released. This takes more time and effort, he added.
