Damaged stretch makes commuting risky

Residents around MGR Nagar using the stretch of Anna Main Road especially motorists suffering due to damaged roads it is said that metro water had dug up the road for pipeline works. Before that the condition of the road was better. It is making more dangerous for motorists, with the lighting making it worse at night.

The department had dug up the road for pipeline repair work near the ESI Hospital and the MGR Nagar market. However, post the pipeline repair, the lane was left in dire need of repair.

Prema a resident of 1st Sector says that she cannot spot the potholes and uneven patches mainly on night time. "We cannot see the pothole at all, and our vehicles eventually hit it. As a regular commuter, I have faced this many times," she continued.

Another resident of Nakkeeran Street says that I ride

daily on this road so I ride cautiously it cannot be expected for someone who ride newly on this road can ride smoothly. Even though road patch work completed in many places but the gravels spread all over the road is very risky.

Even three days before one person skidded on this road like wise many accidents go unreported. Residents urge immediate repair work on the road and improve better street lighting. We hope GCC would take swift action to ensure safe travel for all. As thousands of vehicles use this stretch daily, civic activists warn that ignoring the issue could lead to major accidents.



Agnipureeswarar

Temple, Thirupugalur

This is the 192nd Thevara Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam and the 75th Sthalam on the south side of the river Kaveri of Chozha Nadu. These are moovar Padal Petra sthalam. The other Paadal Petra Sthalam Thirupugalur Varthamaneecharam is also in this temple complex.

This is one of the 44 temples on which Moovar has sung hymns to Lord Shiva. Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal has attained mukthi in this place. This Thirupugalur is also the birthplace of Muruga Nayanan, one of the 63 Nayanmars. This is the Sathayam Nakshatra temple.

In Periyapuram, Sekkizhar records that Thirugnanasambandar came to this temple after worshiping Lord Shiva of Thiruchengattankudi. In Periyapuram, Sekkizhar records that Sundarar prayed to Lord Shiva for money to celebrate Panguni Uthiram thiruvizha at Thiruvarur with Paravai Nachiyar. Lord Shiva changed the brick that supported Sundarar's head during his sleep. But Sundarar didn't mention this legend anywhere in his hymns. Moovar, ie, Thirugnanasambandar, Thirunavukkarasu Swamigal, Sundarar, and Vallalar have sung in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple.

Moolavar : Sri Agnipureeswarar, Sri Saranya Pureeswarar, Sri Konapiran. Consort : Soolikambal, Sri Karuntharkuzhal.

Some of the Salient features of these temples are.....

The temple faces east with a Moat/agazhi around, believed to be excavated by Banasuran. The first level, Rajagopuram, is of 5 tiers, and the second level is of 3 tiers. In between the two Rajagopuras,

Dwajasthambam, balipeedam, and Rishabam.

Moolavar is of swayambhu, slanting towards the North. In koshtam Vinayagar, Natarajar, Dakshinamurthy, Agasthiyar, Lingothbavar, Brahma, Durgai, Pichadanar, Alingna Kalyana Sundarar, and Sembian Mahadevi worship Lord Shiva.

In the praharam, Chinthamaneeswarar, Narthana Vinayagar, and Shiva Lingam are worshiped by Bharadwaja and Appar's Iykaya sirpam. In the inner praharam, Chandrasekar, Agni, Arupathumoovar, Panchalingas, Appar Sannathi, Vatapi Vinayagar, Subramaniar, Shiva Lingam worshiped by Maharis, Mahalakshmi, Saneeswarar, Navagrahas (Navagrahas are in L shape), Saraswati/Kalaimagal, Annapoorani, Kalasamharar, Agora Lingam, 63var, Bootheswarar, Vatapi Ganapati, and Bhavitchenswarar. Paintings of Shiva turning the Bricks into gold and Agneeswarar are on one Praharam wall. Ambal is in a separate Sannathi near Rajagopuram.

The Shiva Lingas worshiped by Lord Muruga, Mahavishnu, Neelakanda Sivachariyar, Sages Jamadagni, Bhardwajar, Thatheesi, Vyasar, Birugu, Pulasthiyar, Jabali, Indra, and Varadarayar are in the praharam.

Natarajar Sabha and Urchavars are in the mandapam. Urchavar Agneeswarar is with 1 Agni, 2 faces, 7 hands, 3 Thiruvadikal/Legs, 4 horns, and 7 Jyothis- worth seeing. The other Urchavars are Mooga Surasamharam Moorthy and Somaskandar. Ramanatheecharam (Thirukkannapuram) urchavar are also kept in this temple for safety reasons.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Moovar has sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple, this original temple might have existed before the 7th century. The same was reconstructed as a stone temple during the Chozhas period (maybe during Rajaraja-I -I) and further extended by Pandya, Vijayanagaras, and Nattukottai Nagarathars.


Solo Exhibition of artist Venkatachalapathy

A document has been found that donated land to the Vadapalani Murugan Temple in Chennai. Vadapalani Murugan Temple is one of the temples popular with devotees in Chennai. According to the history of the temple, three Thambirans, namely Saligramam Annaswamy Nayak, Rathinasamy Chettiar, and Pakiyalinga Sengundar, administered the Vadapalani Murugan Temple.

All three of these people have tombs there. In it, Bhagyalingam Thambiran erected the present stone building.


This land donation was registered in the Saidapet Sub-Registry Office on 17th June 1893. This land was purchased on 17th August 1892 and was given as a donation after enjoying it for one year.

It has been stated that the donor can cultivate this land as he wishes; however, it cannot be sold or given away. Land worth Rs 100 has been donated, with a tax of Rs 5.20 per acre. It has been emphasized that the income from this should be used for expenses such as temple ablutions, deepa offerings, etc.

The four boundaries of the donated land are shown, including Duraisamy Gramani's land for sale, the cemetery, etc. Finally, there is the signature of the sub-register and the signatures of the witnesses. One of the witnesses has signed in Telugu and the other in English. A bond of 1 rupee for this has been purchased in Thiruvallikeni, he said.

Will the authorities demolish unused water tank?



Local residents of Periyar Nagar, Valasaravakkam urge concern authorities to demolish the unused overhead water tank.

This tank with capacity of 25,000 liters was constructed in 2000 at MGR Street, Periyar Nagar, Ward 149, Valasaravakkam Zone. At that time, Valasaravakkam was a panchayat. Later, after merging with the GCC, drinking water was supplied from this tank by the Drinking Water Board. Over time, this tank stopped receiving water. Due to lack of use, this tank was abandoned. It is now in a dilapidated and crumbling state.

Local residents have requested that the water tank be demolished and removed with proper safety measures before an accident occurs, as there are residences and a power transformer nearby.

Sewage ponding near the temple causes trouble



Venuganeswarar Temple is one of the oldest Shiva temple situated in Ellaimuthallamman Kovil Street, Vadapalani. Devotees are having difficulty passing through this stagnant sewage water.

The underground sewer on this street has become blocked, and for a few days, sewage has been leaking out with a foul smell and accumulating on the road.

Due to this, devotees coming to the temple are having to hold their noses. Furthermore, motorists and the public passing through that road are facing severe problems.



Signature campaign at WCC

GCC offers door to door services through Namma Chennai App

In Chennai, the Corporation has so far collected and disposed of 470.33 tons of items through its door-to-door service for old sofas, beds, furniture and clothes on Saturdays.

In the Chennai Corporation, 6,500 tons of solid waste is being disposed of daily. At the same time, they were dumping broken sofas, beds, and furniture in garbage bins and on the roadsides because the corporation did not receive them. As a result, the area was found to be in a dirty state. To avoid this, old sofas, beds, furniture and clothes are being removed from homes every Saturday. Accordingly, according to information received from 94 individuals, 42.89 tons of old items were collected. These materials were taken to the incineration plant in Kodungaiyur and burned scientifically. 62 vehicles and more than 200 workers were involved in this work. So far, 470.33 tons of useless items have been removed from 1,288 homes.

Encroachment removed on sidewalk

GCC removed unauthorized encroachments on the pavement in K.K. Nagar. It falls in ward 138, Kodambakkam zone. This road connects K K Nagar and MGR Nagar areas.

Along this road from MGR Canal, there are many shops selling second-hand goods for all building materials including furniture and chairs.

Allegations have been raised that all these shops are occupying the footpaths. In addition, vehicles including load vans, autos, and mini lorries are parked along the road, causing traffic congestion.

In this situation, the corporation employees removed the encroachments on the sidewalk on the 60-foot road early this week.
