Parijatha Vana Nathar Temple, Tirukalar

This is the 222nd Thevaram Paadal Petra Shiva Sthalam and the 105th Sthalam on the south side of the river Kaveri in Chozha Nadu. This place has maintained the same name, Thirukalar, since the Thirugnanasambandar period.

In Periyapuram, Sekkizhar records that after visiting Pandya Nadu, temples came to this Pathaleecharam. After worshipping Lord Shiva of Kollamputhur, Nallaru, Thelicheri, Iyyaru, and Kazhumalam (Sirkazhi) went to Nadu Nadu. But, in actuality, he went to Thirukalar after Thandalaineeneri.

Thirugnanasambandar and Vallalar have sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple.

Moolavar : Sri Parijathavaneswarar, Sri Kalarmulai Nathar, Consort : Sri Amutha Valli, Sri Ilam Kombanaiyal, Sri Azhakeswari.

Some of the salient features of this temple are... The temple faces east with a 5-tier Rajagopuram. There is also a 3 tier second-level Rajagopuram. Dwajasthambam, balipeedam, and Rishabam are between these two Rajagopuras.

In the praharam Navagrahas, Chandran, Brahma, and Vishwakarma worshiped Shiva Lingas, Nalvar, Moshatruvaeswarar, Somaskandar, Sthala Vinayagar, Natarajar, Valli Devasena Subramaniam, and Gajalakshmi.

In the outer mandapa, Ashta bhuja Durga and Sthala Viruksha. Natarajar, Maha Vishnu sannadhi is on the east of Suriyan. Natarajar is of Brahma Thandava murti. A Vidanga Lingam is in safe custody near Natarajar.

There is a separate temple for Ambal, facing east with dwarapalakis. A gold Kavasa was gifted by a devotee who will adorn Ambal on special occasions. Koviloor Mutt Veerasekara Gnanadesika Swamigal's Samadhi, Veda Patasala, Pasumadam, Vedanta Mutt, 63var Guru pooja madam, and a mutt are near this temple. Sadhus are also practicing in this mutt. A Pidari Temple, Ayyanar Temple, and Mariamman Temple are also in this Village.

ARCHITECTURE

The main temple consists of the sanctum sanctorum, antarala, and ardhha mandapam. A 3-tier vesara vimanam is over the sanctum sanctorum.

HISTORY AND INSCRIPTIONS

Since Thirugnanasambandar has sung hymns in praise of Lord Shiva of this temple, the original temple might have existed before the 7th Century, and the same was reconstructed as a stone temple during the Chozha period. Further extended by Vijayanagara. The inscriptions recorded from this temple belong to Chozhas, Pandyas, and Vijayanagaras. As per the inscriptions, this place was called Rajendra Chozhavalanattu, Purangarambai Nattu Thirukalar. Lord Shiva was called as Thirukalar Udayar, "Kalar Mulaitha Nayanar", and "Adaintharkku Arul Seitha Nayanar". (Thirugnanasambandar also mentions the same in his hymns).

Kochadayabarmar Thiribhuvana Chakravarthy Sri Vallabha Devar's 25th reign Year inscription records the historical event of the Capture of Mudaliar Suriyadevar and puts him in jail for not giving the Kani land and Taxes. It also records that Rajarajan Sundara Pandiyadevar came to this place along with Thulukkar (Muslims). During that time, the village was in trouble due to floods and rebellion.

AROUND CHENNAI CITY

Man snatches gold chain from woman, escapes with her bike

GCC to provide cloth bags to households to contain plastics

The Corporation is set to launch a project to provide cloth bags to 50,000 households in the first phase to collect dry waste, including plastic from today.

Corporation collects 6,000 tonnes of garbage every day. There are various challenges in segregating and collecting this garbage.

Lack of awareness among the people and dumping of biodegradable and non-biodegradable garbage in the same bin is harming the environment.

In this situation, Corporation has taken an initiative in collaboration with 'Urbaser Summet' to separate and purchase plastic garbage including bottles. In the first phase, the project of collecting dry waste by giving cloth bags in five zones of the southern region – one among the area is Valasaravakkam is set to start today.

Corporation and 'Urbaser Summet' officials said: Garbage is being collected from five lakh households in the southern region. In this, cloth bags will be given to each household to collect dry waste including plastic, bottles, biscuits, milk packets, cloth, cans and paper. Dry waste should be put in this bag and given to the cleaning staff who comes from house to house. He will put the waste in the bin and give the bag back. This happens every day. Biodegradable waste, including food waste, should not be put in that bag.

In five zones, a target has been set for 50,000 houses that have not been properly segregated, and 5,000 houses will be provided with the bags today. In the coming days, other houses will also be provided. Through this scheme, the environmental damage caused by dry waste will be prevented. They said this.



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Barricade troubles motorists



For the past several weeks, motorists on Ekkattuthangal have been facing severe hardship in negotiating the road. The big barricade has been hindering on the middle of the road. Protecting the damaged manhole. The concern

authorities should place the new manhole cover as soon as possible to avoid traffic congestion as earliest.

Because of the damaged manhole this has also led to a swarm of mosquitoes, raising concerns about the possible spread of infectious diseases like dengue, malaria, etc. Children, the elderly, and those who use the road daily are said to be the worst affected.

If water stagnates on the road, vehicles passing through the area splash it onto the roadside and footpaths, causing distress not only to two-wheeler and four-wheeler riders but also to pedestrians. In particular, the water sticks to parked vehicles, and has turned Ekkattuthangal bridge into a foul-smelling stretch.

The public has urged Corporation authorities to take immediate action and provide a permanent solution by properly repairing the drain and thoroughly cleaning the road and fixing a new manhole.

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Street name board not fixed properly



Street name boards were removed during the stormwater drain and some EB works recently carried out in 11th Avenue, Ashok Nagar. Although a few were reinstalled later, several are damaged, as they were not fixed properly."

Officials of the Greater Chennai Corporation said, "There are no funds available for replacing the damaged street name boards. Repair and replacement works can be taken up only after funds are sanctioned.

Once the required allocation is received, all damaged and missing street name boards in the area will be replaced with new ones."

Corpn identifies 77 caste-linked street names for review

The Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) has begun enumerating street names within its limits to identify and remove caste references. The initiative follows a directive from the Tamil Nadu Social Justice Department to remove or rename caste-linked names associated with residential areas, streets, roads, water bodies and revenue villages across all local bodies in the state.

To implement the initiative, the State Government issued GO 313 through the Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department on October 6. The order provides guidelines for removing or changing public names that contain caste references or promote social discrimination.

The Social Justice Department has instructed the Greater Chennai Corporation to inspect public infrastructure and take appropriate corrective action. A State-Level Vigilance and Monitoring Committee meeting, chaired by Chief Minister Joseph Vijay, is also scheduled to review the progress of the initiative.

77 Chennai Street Names Identified

A GCC official said that officials have been instructed to audit street names and submit zone-wise reports. So far, around 77 street names containing caste references have been identified in the Kodambakkam, Valasaravakkam zones. Reports from the remaining zones are awaited.

Under the guidelines, the action to be taken will depend on how the caste reference appears in the street name. If a caste title is used only as a suffix, the suffix will be removed while retaining the rest of the name. However, if the entire street name is based on a caste identity, the name will be completely changed.

Street names currently under review include Gengu Reddy Road, Brahmin Street, Vanniyar Street, Reddy Street and Dr Nair Road in the Kodambakkam zone. Some chennai street names already changed Several street names in Chennai have already been modified under the initiative.

For instance, GN Chetty Road was renamed Gopathy Narayanan Road. Similarly, Srinivasa Iyer Street and Balakrishna Naicken Street in West Mambalam were shortened to Srinivasa (I) Street and Balakrishna (N) Street, respectively.

The Greater Chennai Corporation's ongoing enumeration is expected to identify more caste-linked street names across the city.

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This road not laid yet



The delay in relaying the road opposite to EB in Ramapuram. A portion of the road has not been relaid for years. Kalasathamman Kovil Road in Ramapuram have been laid but not a portion of opposite to EB sub station. We don't know why only this small portion has been left out for years. This comes at a time when the Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) has been taking steps to expedite the road relaying works. It also imposes fine on the contractors who delay the relaying works post milling.

Babu, a local resident, asked for immediate relaying of the stretch which is affecting thousands of motorists. These roads were dug up a year ago and left unattended.

"Since there are lot of residential surrounding and schools nearby this roads is a vital link to K K Nagar and Porur. Many mini vans and pick-up school children from this area. Many commuters nowadays take longer routes to reach their destination as they don't want to take risks in the night time," said a commuter.

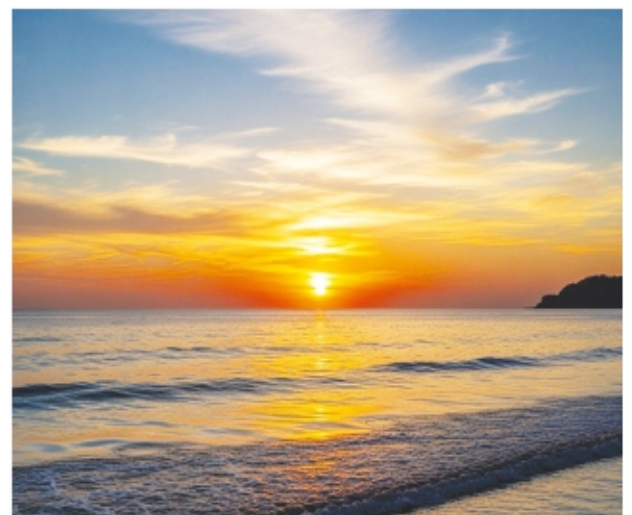
4. Nunavut, Canada:

Trains shifted to Tambaram, Beach & Mambalam

The ongoing Chennai Egmore railway station redevelopment work will temporarily affect several express train services. As part of the redevelopment, some trains will originate from or terminate at Tambaram, Chennai Beach and Mambalam railway stations instead of Chennai Egmore.

Southern Railway has announced revised train schedules for the affected periods. Passengers are advised to check their train details, boarding station and terminating station before travelling.

Mannargudi-Egmore Express to Terminate at Tambaram : The Mannargudi - Egmore Express will operate with revised arrangements from September 4 to October 13.

The train will depart from Mannargudi at 10.50 pm and terminate at Tambaram instead of Chennai Egmore.

The return Egmore - Mannargudi Express will depart from Tambaram at 11.25 pm from September 5 to October 14.

Tiruchy-Egmore Malai Kottai Express to Terminate at Mambalam

The Tiruchy Egmore Malai Kottai Express will terminate at Mambalam instead of Egmore from September 9 to 15 and again from September 21 to October 14.

The train will depart from Tiruchy at 10.35 pm. Passengers travelling to central Chennai should take note of the temporary change and make alternative arrangements to reach their destinations from Mambalam.

Mumbai CSMT-Egmore Express to Terminate at Chennai Beach

The Mumbai CSMT-Egmore Superfast Express will terminate at Chennai Beach instead of Egmore from September 12 to 15.

The train will depart from Mumbai at 10.52 pm during this period.

Salem-Egmore Express Services Revised

The Salem-Egmore Superfast Express will terminate at Mambalam instead of Egmore from September 12 to 15. The train will depart from Salem at 9.30 pm.

Meanwhile, the Egmore-Salem Superfast Express will originate from Chennai Beach at 11.30 pm from September 13 to 16.

Uzhavan Express to Run Late

The Thanjavur-Egmore Uzhavan Express will also be affected by the Chennai Egmore redevelopment work. From September 16 to 19, the train will run 20 minutes late in the Mambalam-Kodambakkam section.

From September 22 to October 15, the train will run 30 minutes late in the same section.

Few time CMRL attendants turn away vehicles citing lack of space

Commuters of Metro Rail have raised concerns over difficulties in accessing parking facilities at Metro stations, alleging that vehicles are sometimes denied entry even when parking spaces appear to be available.

Several users said that parking attendants turn away vehicles citing a lack of space, while vacant slots could reportedly be seen inside the parking premises.

They alleged that some of these spaces were kept aside for frequent or regular users, making it difficult for occasional passengers to park their vehicles. The issue has caused inconvenience particularly for passengers



who depend on Metro station parking to complete the first leg of their daily commute.

Those denied entry are often forced to search for alternative parking nearby, potentially delaying their journeys and adding to congestion around stations.
